Private Event: Toledo Power Squadron Change of Watch

Sally learned a lot about Toledo Sail and Power Squadron (TSPS) while helping Loriann Czerniejewski plan their very successful Change of Watch at MRYC. Here's some interesting information for you:

Can you give MRYC members some information about Toledo Sail & Power Squadron?

TSPS is a group of individuals dedicated to making recreational boating safe and fun. Our members participate by: going on cruises, volunteering their time to teach classes and seminars, performing vessel safety checks and much more. We do complete on-site vessel safety checks that meet Coast Guard guidelines and a sticker is given if the vessel passes inspection.

What programs or classes do you offer and for whom?

We offer the basic safe boating course to the general public for a fee of \$20.00 with an additional fee of \$35 for a book which is not required, but strongly encouraged. This book can be shared by family members if you wish. Any person born after January 1, 1982 must show proof of having taken a basic boating safety course if they operate a boat powered by a motor 10 hp or greater. We recommend everyone takes a boaters safety course. For people who join the Power Squadron, we offer advanced courses such as Boat Handling, Weather, Navigation and much more. How can MRYC partner with your organization to benefit both?

TSPS can partner with MRYC to provide safety training to your members. The partnership would mean you would have knowledgeable members and there would be more safe boaters on the water.
