#### **MRYC Shines Brightly at AYC Commodores Ball Weekend!**



It was a proud weekend for MRYC as our storied history came full circle. In 1925 MRYC along with Toledo Yacht Club, Bay View Yacht Club, Ottawa River Yacht Club and Riverside Yacht Club got together to form a consortium of clubs to promote and encourage yachting, yacht building and yacht racing. Over the years the purpose of The Associated Yacht Clubs (AYC) has expanded into promoting ecology, fellowship among member clubs, boat safety and education.

In 1925 and 1926 Commodore T Schmidt from MRYC became the first AYC Commodore. He was followed by J Fraiser in 1930, J Simmons in 1932, A. Ross in 1933-35, H. Steger in 1940, W. Woerhrie 1942, L. Ott 1945-46, D. Gill 1967, Brent Schneider 2009 and now we can proudly announce that Past Commodore Jay Crum and Lady Denise were sworn in as the 2023 AYC Commodore.
